LAPTOP CONECTIONS

NOTE 1

Some new laptops screens are now able to work at resolutions above the standard 800x600 or 1078x768 that are used by most Data Presenters (LCD Projectors). This and other technicalities may make using your laptop with our equipment difficult. To overcome most of these problems it will be necessary to switch off your laptop screen and work from the projected image from the Data Presenter. This is what is known as the active display.

Therefore it is important for you to know how to change the active display.

There are 3 active displays options :-

- 1 Presentation on Laptop screen only.
- 2 Presentation displayed from Datapresenter only.
- 3 Presentation on Laptop and from Datapresenter..

It is important that you know how to change between each of these, especially if your computer is set to option 1. Please consult your laptop handbook.

The usual control keys are:

Fn Key + F4, Fn Key + F5 or Fn Key + F8

Note Data Projectors come with a warning that they may not work with some Laptops or Notebooks. I would therefore advise all laptop users to bring a backup copy of their program on disc, acetate or in printed form.

NOTE 2 Datapresenter connections.

All Datapresenters in the CMEC centre work to a Resolution of 1032 x 768. If your Laptop or Notebook work to a higher Resolution, they may not work.

To see the Resolution settings you need to go to the Control Panel and Settings. Select the 1032 x 768 setting and apply. Follow instructions.

If this does not work, set Laptop to Screen only mode or set the Resolution to 800 x 600.
